Adventure Activities License – We have been inspected by the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority (AALA) and our risk analysis and management systems were found to be at least satisfactory. Staff Competence and Qualifications – Where it is required, all staff either hold a relevant National Governing Body (NGB) qualification, or a statement of competence signed by an appropriately experienced and qualified person consistent with the requirements of the Licensing Regulations. Copies are available for inspection at the AU office.

Child Protection - Our policy is consistent with current good practice in this area and meets current statutory requirements. Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) checks are carried out on all staff, trainees and volunteers (where appropriate).

Risk Assessment and Operational Procedures – These have been inspected as part of our Adventure Activities Licence and are available for inspection at the AU office. They have been approved by the local authorities.

Transport – AU owns 3 minibuses all insured and compliant with current legislation. Checks are carried out each time they are used. Our drivers have D1 minibus and E1 trailer entitlements as appropriate and have passed the East Sussex CC minibus practical driving test or MIDAS test.

Equipment - All equipment provided will be fit for purpose and is inspected as part of our adventure activities licence. Records of equipment checks are available for inspection at the AU office.
